- 8. Amjad needs to stick to the 10 point advice of Shaykh Muhammad which he gave to SP dated 29/2/1426. So, Amjad due to not having studied the Deen in an Islamic university nor under scholars should stick to only transmitting the works of the scholars in a trustworthy manner without his own additional, out of context and deceptive commentary.

May Allaah guide him for indeed he is deluded.

- 11. Amjad should refrain from writing articles related to issues of Jarh wa Tadeel since this science in particular requires men who have knowledge, insight, wisdom, justice, Taqwa, precision and truthfulness. However, what we find in Amjad's articles is that he is deficient in regards to the above mighty attributes.

It is quite surprising that one of the main 'Duaat' from SP has not been able to establish a Salafi Masjid in his locality for many years. The Salafi community and the Salafi families in Middlesbrough have suffered enough and have been neglected enough! It is astonishing how Amjad has been content with praying Jum'ah with the people of innovation for so many years and has allowed the local Salafis to do the same!
